1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016. Appendix S.
- 1.2 Class rules will apply.
- .1.3 ISAF Sailor Classification, Regulation 22 will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 2.3 All boats shall be equipped with VHF.

3 ENTRIES

4 SCHEDULE AND AFTER SAIL

Saturday 30 May.

09.00-09.30 Registration at the local race office.

09.45 Skippers meeting

11.00 First warning signal of the day.

No warning signal after 16.00

After Sail with food and fitting beverages and Daily First Prizegiving at Sune Carlsson Båtvarv after racing.

Sunday 31 May.

10.00 First warning signal of the day.

No warning signal after 15.00

Prizegiving at Sune Carlsson Båtvarv as soon as possible after racing.

5 MEASUREMENT CHECKS

Measurement checks may be performed.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted before the regatta.

7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be on Baggensfjärden in Saltsjöbaden.

8 THE COURSE

At least 4-6 course races on a windward-leeward course are planned unless otherwise stated in a separate Notice of Race.

9 STARTING PROCEDURE

In addition to traditional starting procedures with flag signals and horn, there will be an additional countdown via VHF.

10 SCORING

The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

11 PRIZES

The best boats will be awarded (40% of the startlist).

The Pelle Gedda Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner.

Daily First prizes will be awarded.
